

**When do tickets go on sale?**

Tickets will be on sale at the front desk starting April 18. Tickets are limited. Each family is limited to 3 tickets per performing gymnast. TICKETS WILL NOT BE SOLD AT THE DOOR THE DAY OF THE EVENT.

**Does my gymnast need a ticket?**

Your gymnast will not need a ticket for the show in which they are performing. If a gymnast wants to watch a show in which they are not performing, they will need to purchase a ticket.

**What are the ticket costs?**

Ticket sales will begin April 18 until sold out. Adults \$15, Children ages 10 and under \$5. Children under 2 are free and must sit on an adult's lap (if you would like for them to have their own chair you must purchase a child's ticket).

**Is my ticket valid for all shows?**

Tickets will be sold per show and are not transferable to additional shows.

**When will showtimes be released?**

Once registration comes to an end on March 25, we will assign our gymnasts into groups. We will announce the show times on April 18, when tickets go on sale.

**How should my gymnast have their hair done for the show?**

Each gymnast should have their hair pulled back away from their face. Hair spray and clips (no bobby pins) are suggested. No bows/barrettes that will inhibit any rolling.

**Is there handicap seating?**

Yes, we will be reserving a small section for handicap seating, however the entrance to our building is not handicap accessible. If you need assistance with entrance stairs, please let us know ahead of time.

**Can I purchase a medal and/or leotard if my child is not participating in the show?**

Medals and leotards are reserved for our show participants, however if we have any leotards/t-shirts left after the show they will be on sale in our pro-shop.

**When will the leotard and shirts be ready to pick up?**

Leotards and shirts will be available to pick up the week before the show at the front desk. If these items arrive at an earlier date, we will email all participants to pick up early.

**Can my gymnast wear shorts with her leotard?**

Yes, a pair of black, form-fitting shorts (bike shorts) over top of the leotard.

**Will masks be required?**

Masks will be optional unless there is a new mandate.
